

RMN Assistant Head Official (AHO) Duties EVENT ONLY Doc

The function of the AHO is to provide a 2nd layer of leadership and command for RMN Events. AHO will work to keep the HO informed of decisions and issues.

Due to the need for the Head official (HO) to be off the mat at all times because of the vast amount of functions he will perform during the event, RMN asks that the AHO work in a rotation on the mats while performing this job.

AHO will have the same functions as the HO (listed below) but will have additional duties which are listed in the ADDITIONAL duties section. The AHO has to delegate to the POD Leaders giving them clear and concise directions on their job duties for the event.

ASSISTANT HEAD OFFICIAL (AHO) EVENT ONLY DUTIES

- Conducting officials meeting
- Conduct coaches meeting (if necessary)
- Creating rotation and mat assignments
- Direction to POD leaders - Event Start - Table help and officials ready
- Handling issues concerning rule judgements and application of NFHS rule book and RMN MODIFICATION DOCUMENT.
- Reviewing calls made on the mat for the POD Leaders (PL)
- Reviewing video (if necessary)

ADDITIONAL DUTIES

- Informing HO and Tournament Directors of any issues and judgements that would help to ensure a smoothly run event according to RMN standards.
- Work to ensure officials are on the mat are working until all matches are completed
- Working with HO to ensure that rotations and groups are working smoothly
- Mentoring PL
